# ASSEMBLY, USE AND CARE OF YOUR KENNEDY PRODUCT

To assist you in the assembly, use and care of your new Kennedy tool box, we have compiled the notes below to help you keep your tool box operating like new for many years to come.

## Assembly

**Casters**—Assembly requires flat tip screwdriver and ½" socket or ½" open end wrench.

(2) rigid and (2) swivel with toe brakes. Bolts, lock washers and hex nuts furnished for assembly to cabinet.

Unit with bottom front panel - open bottom drawer, lift and open panel for caster mounting.

Units with full drawers - bottom drawer must be removed for caster mounting. Lay cabinet on its back when mounting casters. Line up caster holes to bottom pan or reinforcement rail and fasten with round head of bolt to the outside.



**Tubular End Handle** —Requires flat tip screwdriver.

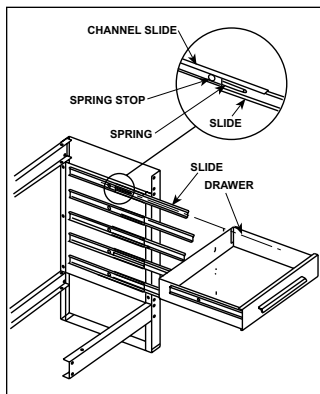
Side handle should be mounted on the same end as the swivel casters.

1. Mount end handle on same end as swivel casters.
2. Bracket holes must line up to double set of holes in body. Attach each bracket with (2) ¼" x ½" screws.



## Use

### Drawer & Slide Removal



#### I-Beam Friction Slides

**Note: Unload drawer prior to drawer removal.**

To remove drawers and slides, pull drawer all the way out. Insert screwdriver and lift drawer slide spring out and down on both sides and remove the drawer. To insert drawers, reverse the process.

#### Ball Bearing Slides

**Note: Unload drawer prior to drawer removal.** To remove drawers and slides, pull drawer all the way out, depress clear lever on each slide, removing drawer at the same time. To re-install drawer, insert guides on drawer sides into slides and firmly close drawer all the way.

### Lock Removal



1. Insert flat tip screwdriver between lock and retainer clip. Pry clip away from lock.
2. To Assemble: Insert lock with cam in upright position and force retainer clip over lock.

Roller Cabinets—rod with cam must be in upright position in cabinet. Turn key in lock counter clockwise and insert into cabinet while aligning the rod end into back of lock. Attach retainer clip over lock.

**NOTE: Record key number and place in safe keeping.**

## Care

**Slides**—A light coating of oil on the friction slide will preserve and provide easy movement of parts.

**Cleaning of Finish**—Your Kennedy wrinkle finish unit can be cleaned periodically with WD-40 or Murphy's Oil Soap. The smooth finish units should be cleaned with a soft cloth, dampened with warm water.
